Now the dust has settled we can look back at Oklahoma! with clear eyes. The show was a massive success both artistically and financially. The reviews were glowing, the audience reaction humbling. The ticket sales stunning and the final profit amazing. This was all because we had an excellent cast and production team who all worked hard together to achieve a stunning result. Slap yourselves on the back! On Saturday evening I sat in the audience with my family (and paid for a ticket) so that I could really appreciate it as an audience member. It was truly excellent and I enjoyed every minute. When it got to the ballet I could not believe over 90 minutes had already passed. What better compliment can I pay, I hadn't wriggled, and my backside wasn't hurting. Act Two shot by and I was genuinely sorry when the curtains closed.

A training video was filmed on three performances and I have now started to edit it. Once finished I expect to offer a four disc box set consisting of DVDs of Act I and Act II, an audio CD of the show songs (nice to play in the car) and a CD of show photos. Following many requests for a **Video Social** evening, this will be held on **Friday 7th July at St Marks**. The evening will start **sharp at 7.00pm** to allow for the length of the show. At 8.40pm we will serve a **Fish 'n Chip Supper** (£6.50 per head) which will be followed by Act Two. More details will be circulated from Terry via Email & Facebook, but **bring your own nibbles and drinks**. Also, once the box set is ready I will contact you with details, but it is hoped that they will be available at the Video Evening.

As 'Masquerade' gets going, work is already underway for the next main production 'My Fair Lady'. We will be posting information on the special group site on Facebook. The main dates you need to put in your diaries are the Presentation Evening on **Wednesday 13th September** at Barton at 7.30pm. The casting will be on **Sunday 1st October** 10.00am - 5.00pm at Sopley Village Hall. Libretto and score and all the details are on the Facebook site. This is a very different show from Oklahoma! but will offer new challenges, but I know we will rise to the occasion. In the meantime start spreading the message to your family and friends and make sure they have the show dates of **25-28 April 2018**.
