Chairman's Update

It has been quite a time since I sat down to write for the Society newsletter and sadly the intervening months had largely been silenced for reasons beyond our control. However, the Society has bounced back with great productions, delivered despite the COVID concerns, and it is time to reflect on an amazing year so far, as well as an Autumn season in 2021.

Do You Wanna Dance was in the mix for nearly 2 years so when we finally got to start rehearsals it had been thoroughly reviewed by a wonderful team of writers and musician helpers. Auditions were joyful and rehearsals started in September last year with great enthusiasm. The Show, at the end of November, was a resounding success with almost sell out audiences at the Forest Arts Centre every night, so we truly felt like the we had picked up from where we had had to stop in 2020.

Throughout the Autumn of 2021 the preparations for our Spring 2022 production were underway and CHESS, The Musical became my main focus. This was a difficult and challenging show from the get go and there was always an undercurrent that this was not a show that MILTON should be taking on, but I do like a challenge & I had nurtured this musical for several years so I knew how to deliver as well as how it should look on stage. Finding a cast was easier than expected and auditions were popular, with choices for all the lead roles as well as a significant ensemble requirement based on my choice of where to use a chorus in the final production. The sad intervention of the War in Ukraine in February this year was something we could not have foreseen, and initially we considered having to pull the show on the grounds that the politics were too controversial, however support from the world of theatre and The Regent Centre, not to mention the cast made it easier for us to decide to persevere and I'm so glad we did as the result was an amazing production with critical acclaim and wonderful reviews, and despite the huge stress of finding audiences, we did manage decent houses for all 5 shows. However, the icing on the cake is that we have raised £2000 for the Disaster Emergency Committee Appeal for **UKRAINE!!!**

Looking to the future, Plans for WESTENDERS at the Forest Arts are fully formed and KIPPS the New Half a Sixpence is scheduled for April 2023 at the Regent Centre. AND, finally, the winds of change are blowing and both Melva our wonderful Society Secretary and I, are stepping down from committee at the end of the current year.


